 ing that I must shortly depart this life do make this my  
 last will and testament

Item 1<sup>st</sup> My soul I commit into the hands of All-  
 mighty God who gave it trusting in the atoning merits  
 of my Saviour Jesus Christ

Item 2<sup>nd</sup> I direct that my body be decently buried and  
 all my just debts be paid by my executor hereinafter named  
 Item 3<sup>rd</sup> I give and bequeath to my nephew  
Amos Braden my horse, bridle and saddle.

Item 4<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath and devise to my  
 brother A. D. Braden and my sisters Harry & J. Braden  
Polly Ann Braden my land to wit One hundred and  
 sixty Acres lying in the county of Montgomery share &  
 share alike to be equally divided between them I request  
 and desire that my brother A. D. Braden take care of  
 my two sisters above named

Item 5<sup>th</sup> The amount which Mr. Allen Johnson  
 owes me I wish divided equally between my brother  
John Braden and my two sisters above named

Item 6<sup>th</sup> I wish the amount which I owe the Corporation  
 of Georgia as a balance due for my horse may be paid

out of the amount for my services

Item 4th I hereby constitute and appoint and nominate my brother

A D Braden my Executor of this my last will and Testament
