

In the Name of God: Amen.

I Joseph H. Dennis of the County of Fulton and State of Georgia, being of sound and disposing mind, and memory, and being desirous to settle my worldly Affairs while I have strength so to do do make And publish this my last Will and testament, hereby revoking all wills by me at any time heretofore made.

And first I Commit my Soul to God who gave it and my body to be buried in the Cemetery in the City of Greensboro Georgia, And all my other prop-
erty I dispose of as follows

Item 1st I wish my Executors as soon as possible after my death to pay my debts, And first the debts incurred for a water, in which I desire to be buried, And my Physicians bill for services during my last sickness, And that J. Zimmerman man of Greensboro Ga, shall superintend my burial and the construction of the Vault as heretofore directed.

Item 2^d I give to my father Isaac Dennis who lives in Warren County New Jersey the sum of Ten thousand and eighty 74/100 dollars, the amount claimed by him for money advanced to me from time to time.

Item 3^d I give to my brother Robert F. Dennis of New Jersey in trust for the sole and separate uses of my beloved Sister Margdⁿ Wain wife of Robt Blair & Sarah F. Poake, widow of F. F. Poake, does the sum of Three hundred and fifty dollars to be applied to the purchase of a good family house of Canadian Stock, & Buggy, Carriage & household and my brother may select, And if necessary for the expense of making the purchase twenty five dollar over and above the amount before said, my Sister above named, to have possession of the house & Buggy and my said brother to have Absolute Control of said house and Buggy for the benefit of my Sister Hoping that my father & brother in Law, Robt Wain may have interest enough to find the house and supply another in case of death, giving to them and the same heirs, the privilege of doing them in case of emergency, but shall not on any Account make a faral or strait house of him, said house to be under the exclusive care of my brother R. F. Dennis and all the said house should be taken possession of and

used by Lewis Dennis or any other person
 ever for draft or otherwise than the said horse
 and buggy shall be sold by R. F. Dennis and the
 proceeds applied to the sole and separate use of my
 said sisters, as my brother R. F. Dennis may deem
 most advantageous to them.

Item 4th I give to my beloved brother Robt. F. Dennis
 my interest in the Ridge Farm, coming to me from
 my Mother's Estate, the said Ridge Farm being in
 Warren County State of New Jersey and request
 that he will keep it for his two sons.

Item 5th I give to all the children which my
 brother R. F. Dennis and my sister Sarah McPeck
 now have (except F. H. Peck, son of Sarah McPeck
 to whom I give one dollar) all my estate after paying
 my debts and the legacies herein before bequeathed.
 All my other Neicks and Nephews being well enough
 off without further assistance from me.

Item 6th I further desire that the three hundred and
 fifty dollars bequeathed to my brother Robt. F. Dennis
 in trust for my sisters, shall be paid as soon as poss-
 -ible after my death.

in trust for my sisters, shall be paid as soon as poss-
ible after my death.
