I will and desire that my estate be divided as follows
The interest on income of \$50,000 hundred dollars during her natural life and after my death the said fifty thousand dollars to be equally divided among my children except Frederick C. Hargraves and to his wife five hundred dollars the other children Edwin C. and William, Mary H. Hargraves, Kelly C. and Sarah Hargraves, Harriet C. Hargraves, Martha Hargraves, Hannah H. Hargraves, William Hargraves, John Hargraves. In equal distribution with all the above named children except the said F. C. Hargraves as above
all my estate I desire to be sold by my executor

to the best advantage and after deducting the said fifteen
hundred dollars as above the residue after paying all just demands to be equally
divided with the above named children except H C Cotton to be two join dollar
signed sealed and published as the last will & testament of Margaret O
Hargrove who signed the same in our presence & each of signed the
