except Mrs. Edwin W. Holland and her late son ~~James~~
dollars the other division Edwin C. and William, Henry
H. Harington, Nelly & Ruth Anna H. Harington Martha H. Harington
Martha Harington Maria H. Harington William Harington John P.
Harington. The equal distribution with all the above
named children except the said H. C. Harington as above
all my estate I desire to be sold by my surviving

to the best advantage and after deducting the cost of printing
hundred dollars as above the residue after paying all just demands to be equally
divided with the above named children except H C Hargrove to be given him
a sum equal to the last will & Testament of Margaret S.
Hargrove who signed the same in our presence & the rest of signed the
same to be given him the same amount as the above named children
