Item 1st I desire and direct that my body be buried in

Condition and Circumstances, in life, My Soul I trust
will return to God who gave it

Item 2nd I desire and direct that all my just debts be
paid, by my Executors herein after Mentioned & appointed

Item 3rd I give and bequeath the house that I now
live in to my wife Margaret during her Natural life
and after her death it is my wish and desire that
my Brothers, James and Patrick shall have the said
house, and lot Shan and Shan Ahke, said lot is fronting
on Gilmer Street One hundred feet, and on Collins Street
as far back as my Executors hereinafter Mentioned shall
designate, all in the City of Atlanta State and County
aforesaid.

Item 4th It is my wish and desire that my Executors
hereinafter Mentioned, shall sell as much of the above
mentioned property, on Collins Street as will be necessary
to pay all my debts, and defray all my expenses in
the aforesaid stand

Item 5th It is my wish and desire that my brother
Patrick shall have the right of an Open Lane or Alley
from Collins Street back to his lot, at least fifteen feet
wide to be laid out by my Executors hereinafter Mentioned

Item 6th It is my wish and desire that my wife Mar-
garet shall have the right to sell her claim when all my
just debts are paid

Item 7th It is my wish and desire that James Lynch
and John Lynch shall act as my Executors to this
last Will and Testament with the right and power
to claim all other property whether Real or Personal
to give it its just distribution

as far back as my Executors hereinafter mentioned shall
designate, all in the City of Atlanta State and County
aforesaid.

Item 4th It is my wish and desire that my Executors
hereinafter mentioned, shall sell as much of the afore
mentioned property on Collins Street as will be necessary
to pay all my debts, and to pay all my expenses in
the aforesaid things.

Item 5th It is my wish and desire that my brother
Patrick shall have the right of way from his lot or alley
from Collins Street back to his lot, at least fifteen feet
wide to be laid out by my Executors hereinafter mentioned.

Item 6th It is my wish and desire that my wife Mar-
garet shall have the right to sell her claim when all my
just debts are paid.

Item 7th It is my wish and desire that James Lynch
and John Lynch shall act as my Executors to this
last will and testament with the right and
to claim all other property whether Real or Personal
to give it to the just disposition.
