Minor heirs of Robert Alexander deceased:
Now if the said John P. Alexander does well
and truly demean himself as a Guardian aforesaid,
agreeable to letters of Guardianship bearing
even date herewith, and according to law in
such cases made and provided, the above
obligation to be void otherwise to remain in
full force and Virtue.
