 Gilmer County } I Charles Wakefield of the County
 and State aforesaid, being weak
 in body and declining in age but of sound mind
 memory and discretion and considering the
 uncertainty of mortal life and the certainty
 of death, do make and publish this my
 last will and Testament, in manner and
 form following (to wit)

I give my soul to God from whence it
 came, and my body into his hands at his
 disposal: And in regard to my earthly af-
 fairs I do hereby appoint Thomas Wakefield
 and Alexander Wakefield my only lawful
 Executors whom are my sons.

I give and bequeath to my son Alexander
 Wakefield to take effect at and after the
 death of myself and my wife my plantation
 wherein I now live, in Gilmer County, which
 is his full portion of my property and all
 I intend him to have; all the balance of
 my property and effects I will shall be
 sold to the highest bidder after the death of
 myself and my wife, and none to be sold
 or otherwise disposed of. If I should die first
 untill after the death of my wife, but she
 is to enjoy have and enjoy it should she out-
 live me as long as she lives: And when
 sold, I first give and bequeath to my son
 Robert Wakefield and my daughter New-
 ey Moon four hundred and sixty dollars
 each; I give and bequeath to the heirs of
 my son John Wakefield three hundred
 dollars to be equally divided between
 them or their representatives and

after the several divisions as above named
are made, I will and wish the balance of my
effects to be equally divided between my sons
Thomas Wakefield, Robert Wakefield, and my
daughter Nancy Moore.
