Gilmer County May 3rd 1844.

In the name of God I solemnly be it remem-
bered to all men the these presents that I Enoch
Smith being now in my right mind and
having no proper reason, but being about 80
by God's gift of age, and knowing that it is ap-
pointed for all men once to die, have thought
to make this my last will and Testament, as
follows: First I give and recommend my soul
to God who gave it, and my body to the dust
from whence it was taken, to be buried in
plain decent order. Secondly, as touching
my worldly effects wherewith God hath bless-
ed me with, I give and bequeath as follows.
To David Smith, Hannah Prather, Samuel D.
Smith and the children of Joel Smith and
Asahel Smith, that is each family of the
Orphans of the two deceased sons, are to have
an equal share with the three living heirs
above mentioned, to be equally divided
between them; And I do make appoint
Henry Wrenner and John Prather the Execu-
tors of this my last will. I wish them to
sell the property, and collect the the money
and after paying all reasonable expenses
to make the dividend as mentioned in
the above Will.
