

Georgia: Know all men by these presents
Gilmer County: That we John B. Dickey,
George W. Dickey, Burton T. Dickey and
Elisha W. Chastain are held and firmly bound
unto the honorable the justices of Inferior Court
of said County, sitting for Ordinary purposes
and their successors in office, in the just and
full sum of twelve thousand dollars, for the pay-
ment of which sum, to the said Justices as afore-
said and their successors in office we bind our-
selves, our heirs, executors and administrators
in the whole and for the whole sum, jointly
and severally, firmly by these presents.
Sealed with our seals, and dated this twen-
ty-second day of September eighteen hun-
dred and forty-two.

The condition of the above obligation is such that
if the above bound John B. Dickey temporarily appoint-
ed administrator of the estate of George Dickey late of said
County, Georgia, do make a true and perfect inventory of
the estate both real and personal of said deceased which
have or shall come to the hands, possession, or knowledge
of the said John B. Dickey, or unto the hands or posses-
sion of any other person or persons for him, and the same
so made do exhibit unto the said Court of Ordinary
when he shall be thereto required; and such estate do
well and truly administer according to law, and do
make a just and true account of his actings and doings
therein when he shall be thereto required by the Court of
Ordinary for said County, and all the rest of said estate
which shall be found remaining upon the account of
said administrator, the same being first allowed by the
Court, shall deliver and pay to such person or persons respect-
ively as are entitled to the same by law; and if it shall here-
after appear that any last will and testament was made
by the said deceased, the same be proven before the
