The within last will and testament of
Robert Alexander having been duly proven
at a called term in open Court upon
the oaths of Hawkins H. Price and Coke
A. Ellington: ordered that the same be ad-
mitted to record.

In the name of God Amen,
Be it remembered that I Robert Alexander
of the State of Missouri and County of
Polk in my proper mind and reason and
having consulted the Mortality of my ex-
istence, and knowing that God has decreed
that man must die I first of give soul
to God and my body into his hands to be at
his disposal and at his pleasure: And as
for what worldly goods it has pleased God
to give me I dispose of the same in the
following manner and form.

First, my will is and I do
give and bequeath to my beloved Niece
Peggy Ann Alexander my negro boy Joseph
at my death to her proper use and benefit.

And secondly, my will is, and I do
give and bequeath to my beloved Niece
Narcissa Ann Alexander all the bal-
ance of my estate, after all my just debts
as paid to her benefit and use; And

Thirdly, I do constitute and appoint
Samuel Tate of the County of Cherokee and
State of Georgia my sole executor and
Administrator, and I do ordain and appoint
him to attend to this my last will and

I do hereby set my hand and affix my seal this the third day of February in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty signed sealed and delivered in the presence of us.
