blessed me I do therefore make this my last will and
testament Revoking and annulling all others by me
heretofore made.

First I desire and wish that my body be buried in a
decent and Christian-like manner suitable to my
circumstances and condition in life. My soul I
trust shall return to rest with God who gave it
as I hope for a salvation through the merits
and atonement of the blessed Jesus and Saviour
Jesus Christ.

Secondly I desire that all my last will be paid without delay
by my Executors hereinafter named and appointed.
Thirdly I give bequeath and devise to my beloved wife Appy
Hattaway for and during her lifetime or widowhood
all that tract or parcel of land wherein I now reside
containing one hundred and thirty acres more or
less 134 in the county of Glascok adjoining Lands of
James H. Hattaway William H. Hattaway James H. Hattaway
and others the above described premises is to her for
and during her natural life unless she should marry
and should she marry it is my will and desire that
said Land be sold by my Executors and the proceeds
equally divided between my beloved wife
and I do hereby nominate and appoint my
trustworthy friend Mr. J. B. Borden my Executor to carry
into effect this my last will and testament
