with do therefore make this my last Will and Testament
hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me
1st Item. I desire and direct that my body be buried in
a decent and Christianlike manner suitable to my
circumstances and condition in life, my soul I trust
shall return to rest with God who gave it as I hope
for eternal salvation through the merits and atone-
ment of the blessed Lord and Savior Jesus Christ
whose religion I have professed and as I humbly trust
enjoyed for twenty five years

2nd Item. I desire and direct that all my just debts be
paid without delay by my Executors hereinafter ap-
pointed as I am unwilling my creditors should be
delayed in their rights especially as there is no necessity
for delay

3. Item. I give bequeath and devise to my beloved wife
Mary A. with whom I have lived in the strictest quiet-
for forty three years. lot of land in the 1234th District of
said County known as the lot of land in which I now
reside containing Three Hundred and Twenty five acres
about seventy five acres of which are cleared and in
cultivation with all the rights, numbers, and appurten-
ances to said lot of land in anywise belonging free
from all charge or limitation whatever to let even
proper use benefit and behoof during her natural life
At her death the balance of my children of ~~me~~ to be
made equal to my son William & in value of
land and the balances to be equally divided among
all my children. I also give and bequeath to my
beloved in the same manner all of my perishable
property as it stands at my death

4th Item. The residue of my property both real and per-
sonal wherever and whatever it may be including
that given to my beloved wife Mary A. during her
natural life (after her estate therein is over) to give

bequeath and devise to my children forever
I herein I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife
Mary A. Executrix and my beloved son William C. Houette
Executor of this my last Will and Testament
