family and myself that I should make a
disposition of the property with which a kind
providence has blessed me, do therefore make
this my last will and testament, hereby revo-
king all others heretofore made by me

1st Item I desire that my body be buried in
a decent and christianlike manner suited to
my circumstance and condition in life. my soul
I trust shall return to God who give it and
hope for eternal salvation through the merits
and atonement of the blessed Lord and Saviour
Jesus Christ whose religion I have professed
and humbly trust enjoyed for nearly twenty two
years

2nd Item I desire and direct that all my
just debts be paid by my Executors here-
after appointed

3rd Item I give and bequeath to my beloved
wife Elizabeth Vlesy for and during her natural
life or widowhood only my lands whereon I now live
Except that which is hereafter given to son Daniel C
Vlesy lying in said County containing six hundred
Acres be the same more or less I also give and
bequeath to my beloved wife in the same reserved man-
ner the following negroes to wit, Levi a man about forty
years of age, Faitha a woman about forty three years
old and her youngest child Gacy Dick about eight
years old Rutha a girl about fourteen years old
Two mules or horses such as she may choose from my
stock of mules or horses four cows and calves such
she may choose from my stock of cattle one
yoke oxen & cart Two Sows with their pigs and ten
Sparrows such as she may choose from my stock
also all my house hold and kitchen furniture and
sufficiency of farming utensils to enable her to carry on the
farm and one years support for herself and family

- 4th Item I also give bequeath and devise to my son George F. Wray a lot of Land Situate lying and being in said county on the Georgetown Road containing three hundred acres more or less adjoining land of Justice J. Wicks Bryan Kent and others and known as the Kent place
- 5th Item I give bequeath and devise to my son Daniel F. Wray a lot of land lying and being in said county of Glascock on Rock tree creek containing two hundred and fifty acres more or less beginning at the head of Umphlett's Branch thence down the ^{main} branch to Beechtree creek thence up the creek to Sanders line thence said line to James M. Wray's line thence said line to Augustus Wells thence said line to an unknown corner thence to run due South to the existing corner
- 6th Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Ann Wray wife of Hansome S. Wray and her children for her sole and separate use and during her natural life free and exempt from the debts and liabilities of her present or future husband the following property to wit, one negro girl Jane about 18 years old and two hundred dollars to be paid to her out of my Estate and on her decease to go to such child or children as she may leave
- 7th Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Francis Ann Wray and her children for her sole and separate use for and during her natural life free and exempt from the debts and liabilities of a future husband the following property to wit, one negro girl Maria about twenty years old and four hundred dollars to be paid to her out of my Estate and on her decease to go to such child or children as she may leave said negro girl and money to be in full of her part of at the first division of my Estate

Item I give bequeath and direct to my Two Sons Samuel H Wry and Marion D. C. Wry a lot of Land lying and being in the County of Glascok on the waters of Red Blue Springs and Dubarts Creeks containing Eight hundred acres Adjoining of the Jefferson line on East and lands of Henry Howesi on the South and Section 9 fifth on the north and known as the fourth Section of the Graves Survey to be equally divided between my said Son Samuel H and Marion D. C. Wry and I also give to my Son Samuel H and Marion D. C. Wry Two hundred dollars each to be paid to them out of my estate

Item The property given to my beloved wife Elizabeth during her natural life after her Estate therein is over I direct that it be sold by my executors and divided equally between all my Children

Item The residue of my property both real and personal whatever and wherever it may be I direct that it be sold and equally divided among my Children that is to say between William J Wry Mary Ann Todd James M Wry George J Wry Sarah Ann Wry Daniel F. Wry Marion D. C. Wry and Samuel H Wry

Item I hereby constitute and appoint my Sons William J Wry and James M Wry Executors of this my last will and testament
