Item 3rd I give bequeath and direct to my only son
 Edward A. Burnett two feather beds and four
 pillowcases with their covers three double

 finishing bed quilts and also one Corn and four
 three hundred dollar notes making twelve
 hundred dollars now not due and unpaid given
 by the south half of Lot of Land number one

 dred and Forty five all situated in the fifteenth
 district and Third Section of Gordon County and
 State aforesaid. Now should Edward A
 Burnett my son not survive to become
 twenty one years of age it is my will and de-
 sire for my husband Willis R Burnett to be
 sole heir of all that I have devised and given
 to Edward A Burnett during his natural
 life and after the decease of W R Burnett
 if Heir should remain uncondemned by the
 heirs it then is my desire and wish for my estate
 to be equally divided between my two misces
 Agnes F Burnett and Mary J Johnson
 and should not the said Mary J Johnson then
 be in life the said Agnes F ~~Johnson~~ Burnett
 then shall be the sole heir or her legal representa-
 tive

Item 4th I hereby constitute and appoint my dear husband
 Willis R Burnett Executor of this my last will
 and Testament and further appoint him the
 Guardian of my son Edward A Burnett and
 also it is my wish and desire for his Guardian
 (after paying my debts) to receive his (said son's)
 money in real estate if he the Guardian con-
 purchase a farm that shall make a desirable
 home
