 this my last will and testament in manner

 without making any sacrifice of my property.

Item 3rd I give, bequeath and desire to my wife
 all of my property both real and personal consisting
 tracts of land off of Nos 317 and 318 1st Dist and
 3rd Sec and all personal property property notes
 money or any other property that may be found
 in my possession at my death during her
 natural life time or widowhood and in the event
 she marries I desire that the property be sold and
 equally divided among my children she retaining
 a thirds part.

Item 4th I desire that as my decease as convenient
 that all of my property be appraised and turned
 over to my wife with privilege in her part of
 selling any part same at public or private sale
 of personal property that she may not need for the
 support of herself and family and to pay debts
 of any remains after my decease.

Item 5th I hereby constitute and appoint my
 beloved wife Francis Darnell my Executive of this
 my last will and testament and if for any
 cause she becomes incompetent to manage my
 business I desire that the Ordinary appoint some
 competent person to assist her or to manage it for
 her and I hereby revoke all other wills heretofore
 made by me.
