Item 1<sup>st</sup> I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner suitable to my Christian Stances in my soul I trust shall return to rest with God who gave it as I hope for salvation through the merits and atonement of the blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ

Item 2<sup>nd</sup> I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without delay by my Executors herein named and appointed

Item 3<sup>rd</sup> I desire and direct that all my personal property be sold also all the town property I own to be sold and the proceeds to be applied or hereinafter directed

Item 4<sup>th</sup> I desire and direct that lots of Land as follows in the 15-District 3 Section Containing 160 acres 213 in the 15-District 3 Section Containing 160 acres 214 in the 14-District 43 Section Containing 160 acres 211 in the 15-District 43 Section Containing 160 acres 122 in the 15-District 43 Section Containing 160 acres 7th section 1, 2, 3, 4, in the 15-District 43 Section Containing 230 acres 164 in the 14-District 43 Section Containing 160 acres 179 in the 14-District 43 Section Containing 160 acres 65 in the 24-District 43 Section Containing 80 acres 1 in the 6-District 43 Section Containing 160 acres 3 in the 6-District 43 Section Containing 160 acres 4 in the 6-District 43 Section Containing 160 acres being all the lands I own in Gordon County be disposed of in the following manner

That the dwelling house and fifty acres of Land to be named so as to include the dwelling orchard Garden Mattle lots to remain for the use of my beloved wife Martha and all my Children so long as my said wife lives or remains single and at her death or marriage to be sold provided my youngest Child is then married if not married the house and property herein named to remain for the use of my minor Children untill all my Children are married then to be sold and the proceeds of said sale to be equally divided between all my Children the other land herein named to be equally divided between all my Children except Robert D. Smith Wm and David E. Barritt said land to be disposed of by the Commission to be selected by my Executors to the best advantage said land not to be sold untill the fourth Generation shall have passed away

Item 5<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my beloved son Robert O  
Barratt ten hundred dollars

Item 6<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my beloved son David E  
Barratt fifteen hundred dollars

Item 7<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my beloved son Joseph W  
Barratt my undivided interest in the South half  
of Lot of land No 34 in the 14 District & 5 Section  
of said County said Land not mentioned in the fourth  
article of this will.

Item 8<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Martha and  
her son John G. Linn my plantation in Bartow  
County in said State to be equally divided between  
them and at the death of my wife all the right-  
title and interest to said land to vest in the said  
John G. Linn and his heirs never to be sold by him

Item 9<sup>th</sup> I desire and direct that the amount herein given  
to my sons Robert O & David E be paid them out  
of the proceeds of the sales of the proceeds of the  
Sale of the personal property herein named so soon  
as disposed of

Item 10<sup>th</sup> I desire and direct that my dwelling house now not  
completed be completed out of the proceeds of the sale  
of the present crop.

Item 11<sup>th</sup> I desire and direct that a reasonable amount of furni-  
ture and other household goods remain unsold for the  
use of my beloved wife and family so long as the house  
is occupied by my beloved wife or any of my children  
but to be sold when the house is sold and the proceeds to be  
distributed the same as the proceeds of the sale of the house  
the amount of furniture and to be designated by  
my Executors

Item 12<sup>th</sup> I desire and direct that remainder of the money and the  
proceeds of the sale of the personal property after  
paying off my debts and the amount given to my  
son Robert O and David E Barratt be equally divided  
between my beloved daughters Mrs. Jane Martha O

My Gold maple by my daughter to my son  
David E Barrett

Item 13 I desire and direct that a sufficient amount of money or provisions be allowed my family for a support for one year the amount to be adjudged by my Executor

Item 14 I give and direct that and bequeath to my beloved wife the more named Mary & baby and Harriet for her own use and benefit

Item 15 I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved sons Joseph W and Arthur D Barrett Executors of this my last will and Testament this May 17 1894
