property be sold and distributed with the above named and
third article (equal).

Fifthly My will and desire is that my negro man Joe
shall have the right to choose his master to live with the said
Negro Joe is not to be sold or considered any part of my
Sixthly I hereby constitute and appoint my friends Mrs
Motter and Moses R. Wilson Executors of this my last will
Testament this December 27th 1864
