Daughter Pamela's Obed's Sundries to the Amount of
ninety Three Dollars Item 6th I have given unto my
Daughter Fatha W. Caswell Sundries to the Amount of
Forty Eight Dollars Note I hereby Constitute And
ordain my Beloved Wife Polly Phillips Executing with
Joshua Phillips And Isaac Middlebrooks Executors to this
my Last Will And Testament hereby Resolving all former
Wills or Wills heretofore by me made as Void of my
hand And Seal this Eighteenth day of May one
Thousand Eight-Hundred And Thirty Two
