

The last will and testament of J. C. Stagg

State of Georgia In the name of God Amen I
 Gordon County James C. Stagg, of the State and County
 aforesaid, being of sound mind
 and capable of disposing of all my property, and
 not knowing the time of my decease, I hereby
 declare the following items to constitute my last
 Will and Testament viz:

First after the payment of all my debts, unpaid
 at the time of my decease, I hereby devise, will and
 bequeath to my beloved wife, Mary, Ann Margaret
 Stagg, all the residue of my property and effects
 of every description whatever, for her sole use and
 benefit during her life.

Second. I hereby will and bequeath to my daughter
 Lizzie Aldora Stagg a support out of my property
 so left until the death of my wife, and then
 still have her support out of the same until
 she is either married or dies.

Third: After the death of my wife, Lilla shall still
 have her support out of the residue, until she marries
 or dies as above provided.

Fourth: At the final division of the residue I
 will and bequeath, to my daughter, Lilla, twenty-five
 dollars 25.00 and the then residue to equally divide
 between herself and my other children or their
 legal heirs.

Fifth: I do hereby constitute and appoint my two
 sons Julian J. and W. B. Stagg, Executors of this my last
 Will and Testament, to carry out the provisions of
 the same Sept. 30th 1889.
