Know all men by these presents that I Verminah Robbin of the County of Gordon and State of Georgia farmer being in good health and of sound and disposing mind and memory do make and publish this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all former wills by me at any time heretofore made. And as to my worldly estate and all the property real and personal or mixed of which I shall die seized and possessed or to which I shall be entitled at the time of my decease I desire bequeath and dispose thereof in the manner following to wit:

First my will is that all my just debts and funeral expenses shall by my executor hereinafter named be paid out of my estate as soon after my decease as shall by them be found convenient. In the next place my will and desire is that my living wife Susanah Robbin have the bed chamber which she brought here at our marriage together with the bedding and furniture thereunto belonging with a set of Furniture Curtains since purchased with all articles of what ever description which she brought with her here and not subject to sale but at her entire and sole disposal and furthermore that she have one tenth part of the proceeds of the amount of the sale hereafter mentioned to be paid to her by my Administrators hereafter mentioned as soon after the sale or collection as may be convenient. Thirdly my will and desire is that all my worldly estate and all the property real personal or mixed of which I shall die seized and possessed or to which I shall be entitled at the time of my decease be sold to the best advantage

in a credit for all sums of more than five dollars with two good responsible securities and for all sums of five dollars and under cash be paid. That legal notice of said sale and that it be made at a suitable time of the year.

And that one tenth part of the proceeds of said sale be deducted from the sum total or amount for the purpose above specified that the remaining nine tenths be distributed among the nine remaining Legates viz: Isaac Pinckett George Manning Luiza Emeline Platter Amanda Annister Rebecca William Dorthe Abington Stephen Ward Amos Clark and Thomas Jefferson Robbins so as to make them all equal in as some have receive different sums of which they are charged whether it be by note which to be considered as a receipt or account to be considered as so much received of the estate but not to be considered in the amount of sale but to be added to the nine tenths to increase the amount therefore to ascertain an equal distribution as above specified.

And I hereby constitute and appoint my two Sons William Dorthe Abington Robbins and Stephen Ward Robbins to be my Executors to execute this my last will and testament in testimony whereof.

I have hereunto signed my name and affixed my Seal and declared this to be my last will and testament in presence of the witnesses hereunto subscribed this eight day of April.
