this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking
and revoking all others by me here to fore made

First - I direct & desire that my body be buried in a decent
& Christian like manner desirable to my Circumstances
Cest & Condition in life My soul I trust shall return
to rest with the God who gave it as I hope for salva-
tion through the merits and atonement of the
blessed Saviour Jesus Christ

Secondly I desire & direct that all my just debts be paid as
early as practicable if I should owe any by my
executors herein after made and appointed

Thirdly I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth
A. Chastain for & during her natural life or widow-
hood only all my property both real and personal
of any & all kinds that I may own or have at my
death consisting of lots of land numberable
hundred & thirty six (196) & one hundred & thirty
seven (197)

And also I do hereby Number one hundred
 & Ninety Eight 198 soul amount 400 Acres. More or Less
 in the 6th District & 3rd Section of originally Camp Town
 Gordon County Ga As Conveyed to me in a deed
 from P Strickland dated Oct 14th 1872 and what
 soever personality I may have at my death to have &
 to hold same as aforesaid only during her Natural
 life a widowhood for the purpose of her own support
 & Support Education & Maintenance of my two
 youngest Children Tennessee Madora & Florence Johny
 Chastain and at the death or Marriage of my said wife
 Elizabeth A Chastain all my property as aforesaid
 to best & be long absolutely and in fee simple to my two
 son Children as aforesaid Tennessee Madora & Florence
 Johny, Chastain my said wife to have no power
 herself or my other Executor to dispose of any of said
 property unless it be comes necessary to sell some of
 the personal property to pay outstanding debts which

 and the same is intended in extinguishment of her right
 of Dower

Worthy I desire & direct that my two youngest Children

 to the utmost extent that the proceeds or profits arising
 from Cultivation of my estate will allow

I desire & will that no more timber be cut or removed from the land before mentioned than is actually necessary for the maintenance of the place.

- 4 All the rest and residue of my property of every kind
and description and wherever situated I wish converted
into money by my executors herein after named
as soon as practicable and it is my will and I direct
that after paying all debts pecuniary legal and the
expences and charges specified in the first clause
of this will the proceeds thereof
