tenures I entreat thereon known as lot
or Fractional lot number three hundred
and Eleven (311) in the fourteenth dis-
trict of the third section during the term
of her natural life and after her death
to be equally divided among my heirs
To my daughter Sarah Ferguson a filly
four years old of a bay color to my daugh-
ter Lucy a horse now near three years old
My other two children William and Adeline
have each had a horse given to them I give
all my other personal property in Cluding my
house hold and Kitchen furniture to my
wife during her natural life to use and dispose
of as her necessities may require

For witness I make constable and appoint
my son William Ferguson my Executor
of this my last will and Testament
