Hargerson of the County of Gordon and State of Georgia being in feeble health but in my sound mind and considering this frail and transitory life do there in and ordain publish and declare this to be my will and Testament That is to say first after all my lawful debts are paid and discharged the residue of my estate Real and personal I give bequeath and dispose of as follows To wit to my beloved wife the Lord and appertinances Situated thereon known as Lot or Fractional lot number three hundred and eleven (311) in the fourteenth ward of the Third District during the term of her natural life and after her death to be equally divided among my heirs To my Daughter Sarah Hargerson a filly four years old of a bay color to my Daughter Emily a horse now near three years old My other two children William and Lucretia have each had a horse given to them I give all my other personal property including my house hold and kitchen furniture to my wife during her natural life to use and dispose of as her necessities may require

Like wise I make constitute and appoint my son William Hargerson my Executor of this my last will and Testament He witnesses whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed my seal this seventeenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty six
