In the name of God. Amen: In the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy six, being in good health and sound in mind, do make the only written last Will and Testament,

3<sup>rd</sup>: Also, Horse and buggy, and stock of cattle and Hogs I also will to my four grandchildren they being the legal heirs of my daughter M. A. M. Hale, deceased, viz: John P. Hale, Frank S. Hale, Emma Hale, Frank S. Hale and Porter Hale, each one Twenty Dollars, at the final distribution of my property. The balance of my property to be equally divided at the death of my wife Ann M. Haynes between the rest of my legal heirs, W. O. Haynes, John W. Haynes, and Virgil H. Haynes.

I also appoint W. O. Haynes John W. Haynes, and Virgil H. Haynes, Executors to my last Will and Testament.
