be paid by my Executor out of any money arising by
the sale of any of my personal Property Gentle monthly
after my Disease Yea & No I will that all my Property
both real Estate as well as Personal which my
wife Elizabeth Jane and my three Children John John
Noblett Rosina Jane Noblett and Thomas Noblett
share alike when my three Children Respect-
ively arrive to the age of Twenty one years my wife
Elizabeth Jane and my three Children to remain on
the plantation wheron I now live and to have the
use of all my property hereafter named or so much
thereof as is necessary to raise my Children and
School them and also to Clothe them If the rest
I will that my land known as the Edmund
Place in Murray County also my Land known as
the Bishop place in Murray County be by my
Executor hereafter to be divided Rent free from year
to year and the proceeds as also the proceeds of
stocks which my wife may see need in raising
and schooling my Children by my Executor
put at interest or used in buying land Sixth
The Lands named in the fifth item together with
the proceeds of the same as provided in the same
item and my plantation wheron I now live
live and all my Negroe namely Charles a man
Rube a man and Silla a woman and
Womack and George a Boy Mary a Girl
and Minnie a Boy Sarah a Girl Jim a Boy
Martha a girl and Isaac a Boy and then

Increase together with all my Personal Property
the otherwise disposed of as is all my Ready Money
to be equally divided between my wife and three
Children above named whom the Children arrive at
the age of Twenty one years Seventy four & will
that my Executor hereafter to be named first Rec-
ponsible Expenses then my Taxes and other expenses of my
children and all other Expenses that may be necessary
to carry into effect this will out of my money
belonging to my Estate Eighty next I nominate an
apprentice Morris Bobbels and George W. Hogan my
Executor and them to be Executrix of the above named
Property and the Persons of my Children until they
arrive to the age of twenty one years
