3rd of this Month or will I further bequeath and sell
that my said beloved wife Sarah to be allowed
and I hereby direct that she obtain and procure any
and all timber for fencing or other purposes off of
any of the Land bequeathed hereof which by me on
this 3rd of this Month or will at her pleasure and at such place
she may point out to be the most convenient
without loss or hindrance for and during her
natural life.

From 6th I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved
wife Sarah S. Prosecutor of this my last will and
testament This the 6th March 1872

consent if they do their claim will be forfeited
so that other to have and to hold it as his alone property
and till he dies, and Mary Alice's Sisters are to come
up to the price of two Cents is all that I can
do for my son John and his children.

Item 31 I will and bequeath to my daughter Peggy Anne
or all the property that she and her husband Robert
Bryant got when married and all that they got after
wards is all that I can do for them only what I
have given to her son Thomas Bryant I sent twenty
five dollars to him while he was in the State and
fifty one bushels of wheat when he came back
from the Arkansas when wheat was selling at
One dollar and fifty Cents per bushel and I
wrote and bequeath to his two daughters Priscilla
the elder and Mary Frances that I will and
bequeath to them the following when they become
of age one half of lot of land lying in the mouth of
the Little River by the number (303) there bounded
on the west part of said lot running the
line from the line of John Abbott to a hickory tree
standing close by the S. E. corner of his house running
west to a white birch tree on the west line
all that I can do for my daughter above named
and her children and grand children
likewise the second lot. now by the number
(303) there bounded on the west

Anne and her only brother John W. Campbell all
that part of the said lot running the south side of the
line beginning thence the center to be long to
them unto the line of William Carter fractional
part is all that I can do for them only our
bed and breakfast and my side board and candle

Dinner Ware my platters is all that I can do for her

 so I will have to close by giving you all my
 Cola home my to one lot to the Rector
 and the rest money to go to pay any just debts
 I owe and my last will of my wife if
 she die leave to sell my house lot your Cola
 the money between equally between all my
 children that I have in Georgia and all my
 personal property to be sold so paying and
 still you may take in buying my house
 the ground No I hope the land will bring a good
 price and in peace for me and
