 second sect all of said lands I bequest to the
 said heirs by name Wm. J. B., Alfred, M. B. and
 Wileys dead children Joshua W. B. and E. S. Ballou
 on the foregoing I have said lands to be valued by
 3 or 5 disinterested freeholders and all my other
 property to be sold and divided equal with my
 4 girls Sarah Davis, Maria Whitel, Agnes Bird
 Wileys Bird and what it lacks of bringing three
 more equal with the Boys the 4 living boys to
 make it up to the girls so that all the shares
 shall be equal and this is not to be subject to
 my debts that is now made or may be made
 hereafter and shall not be sold out of the family
 and either of the Boys may see his interest to
 my part of his Brothers and my Wife Elizabeth
 if she should be left a widow she is to have
 the rent of the farm for her support as long
 as she lives the same as we get now and
 to have my Son J. W. Ballou and
