Also I give bequeath and devise to her the said Carrie L. Walker all the residue or balance of my property of whatever class or character, including Household and kitchen furniture, money notes or accounts after payment of debts and the legacies hereinafter specified, and direct that my Executor, as soon as practicable after payment of the debts and legacies aforesaid, turn over to the possession of said Carrie L. Walker all the property devised her.
