Item 1st

I give bequeath and devise to my wife Nancy
Wenson the following property to wit: One sixth
part of Lot of Land No 232 in the 25th and 3rd
section of Gordon County Georgia said lot of
land to be divided east and west in six equal
parts and so arranged as to include the house that
I now live in, during her natural life then to
revert to my heirs and their children, and also
to have an equal part or division of personal
property and effects belonging to the estate.
This request is made to my wife in lieu of her
whore dower free from all charge or limita-
tion whatever during her natural life.

Item 2nd

I give bequeath and devise to the heirs of
my daughter Nancy Ann White one sixth part
in the division of said lot of land No 232 in
25th and 3rd section of said County during
her natural life and in case she has no heirs
then this part shall also revert to my heirs then
living, and in case she has heirs it shall revert
to it or them, and she is to have the division
that comes next to the house that I now live in
on the south side of the division that is given
to my wife.

Item 3rd

I give bequeath and devise to my son
William Wenson and his heirs the one sixth
part that lays on the north side of said lot of
land.

Item 4th

I give bequeath and devise to my son Amos
Wenson and his heirs the one sixth division
that comes next to the north side of said lot of
land.

Item 5th

I give bequeath and devise to my son James
Wenson and his heirs the second division
south on the north side of said lot of land.

Item 6th

I give bequeath and devise to my son John
Wenson and his heirs one sixth part said lot

of land that was ^{next to my wife's} ~~division~~ ^{division} on the north side. Each of said divisions containing 26 1/2 acres more or less according to the original survey.

Jan 7th I hereby constitute and appoint my friend J. L. Camp Executor of this my last will and Testament. This the 2nd day of January 1888.
