this my last Will and Testament.

1st I give and bequeath to my Wife Nancy R.
Roe and Mary Ann B. Roe Lot of land No. Two
hundred and Twelve in the 7th District and 3rd
section of the County aforesaid. To be taken
during their lifetimes and then to be sold
and equally divided between my heirs and
all my household and kitchen furniture
during their lifetimes then to be sold and
equally divided between my heirs also
one Cow and Calf to be theirs their
lifetimes then to be divided between my
heirs.

2nd The balance of my property to be sold
and my just and honest debts paid and
the remainder equally divided between my
heirs.

I hereby appoint John W. Roe as my
executor Gordon County Wills 1856-4894
last Will and Testament my house and
land this 6th day of December 1884
