

Will of James Grant (60) of Georgia Gordon County
In the name of God, amen:
I James Grant of the County of
Gordon and State of Georgia being
of sound mind and memory and considering the
uncertainty of this frail life and transitionary life do
therefore make, ordain, publish and declare this
to be my last Will and Testament: That is to say
First; after all my lawful debts are paid and
discharged, the residue of my estate real and
personal, I give, bequeath and dispose of as follows
to wit: as I have no children I give to Souseygnie
one half of all my property including the house
where I now live, secondly: I give to Eliza Waters
and Harriett Waters the other half of my property.
Likewise I make, constitute and appoint Walter King
to be executor of this my last will and testament
hereby revoking all former wills made by me.
