and publish this my last will and Testament in manner
and form

Item 1 I give to my beloved wife Margery Scott the home
Place that is the west half of lot of Land No (82) Eighty
nine 3. Section 6. District Gordon County Georgia during
her natural life or widowhood it being a home for her
and my youngest Children during their single life
namely Frances Scott Martha D Scott Cintha D Scott
and Thomas Jefferson Scott I also give to my beloved
wife Margery Scott one White face Cow and Calf one
Sow and pigs four Shoats (Pigs) one bee hive Two sheep
one fine and weather I also will her and my single
Children my Chickens and ducks

Item 2 I will and bequeath unto my oldest set of Children
namely Malinda C Scott now Kallie Margaret Scott
now Terrell Mary Ann Scott now Bennett Eliza Scott
now Denning Frances Scott and Martha Scott nine
hundred dollars to be paid to them amongst them
of which some of the money may be some a portion of
which the receipts will show

Item 3 I will and bequeath to my youngest Children namely
Martha Scott Cintha Scott Thomas Jefferson Scott my
home place at my wife Margery Scott's death or widowhood
It to be appraised to them and them to take it as a part of their
portion of my estate Martha Scott Frances Scott Thomas
Jefferson Scott to have a support from the proceeds of my
farm during their single life up to the death of my beloved
wife or her widowhood
Last I appoint Beryman H Mosteller Executor to this
my will and Testament In witness whereof I have set
my hand and seal this March 29th in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety four
