The Will of Thomas A. Shelor, Decedent

Thomas A. Shelor,

State of Georgia,

Gordon County } In the name of God Amen.

Thomas A. Shelor of said State and County, being of ad-  
vanced age and afflicted with sickness, but of sound and dispos-  
ing mind and memory, do make this my last Will and Testament  
hereby revoking and annulling all others by me heretofore made.

I give, bequests and devise all my property and estate, both  
real and personal, as follows, that is to say:

First: I desire and direct that my body be buried in a manner  
suitable to my circumstances and conditions in life.

Secondly: I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid  
without delay by my Executrix hereinafter named and appointed.

Thirdly: I give, bequests and devise to my beloved wife, Sason  
A. Shelor, Lots of land numbers Sixty Three (63) - Sixty Two (62) - Fifty nine  
(59) and Fifty Eight (58) containing each One hundred and sixty acres  
and also One hundred and ten acres of lot number Sixty one (61). ~~Forty acres~~  
of lot number Thirty two, (32) and thirty acres of lot number Thirty three  
(33) all of above described tract and parcels of land situate, lying  
and being in the first, second and third section of said County of  
Gordon, containing ~~forty~~ [www.georgiapioneers.com](http://www.georgiapioneers.com) hundred and twenty acres;

with all the rights, members and obnoxious to said above described  
land as my wife belonging. To her own proper use, benefit and behoof  
for and during the term of her natural life, with full power to dispose  
of the same by Will, gift or otherwise equally to her children at or be-  
fore her death, as in her discretion she may deem best and proper.  
So if ~~so~~ in her discretion she thinks the interests of the estate may be  
best subserved, she is hereby vested with full power and authority to  
sell and convey any or all of said estate with a view to a settlement  
upon equal terms, as to her seems meet and proper, of the proceeds  
upon her children, to wit: Isobel E. Stroblung, Mary S. Harbin, Virginia  
L. Wright, A. Rebecca Steele, Robt. Jesse Shelor, Joseph W. Shelor, William  
B. Shelor, and Sason Shelor. I also give and bequests to my beloved  
wife in the same manner, with like limitations, the following articles  
as now on and belonging to the farm as said above described lands  
and all my household and kitchen furniture, stock of all kinds, including  
Horses, Mules, Cattle, Hogs &c and all other of my personal property whatsoever  
and effects of whatsoever kind and character, including money and debts  
due and owing to me. To her unrestricted use and control with full  
power to dispose of same as she may deem proper, only looking  
to an equal distribution of the residue of the estate at her death  
between her children aforesaid taking into consideration the advan-

been made to any of them.

Fortyeth: I give, bequeath and devise to my daughter Mary S. Harbin my undivided interest in lands owned by myself and Hiley A. Fletcher lying on the waters of Chellog and Spring creeks in said County of Gordon, upon the condition that she take it at Three Thousand dollars and pay to my beloved wife interest on said sum at the rate of seven per cent. for minimum till such time as my wife may deem meet and proper and upon the payment by my said daughter Mary S. Harbin of such sum as will reduce the corpus of such estate to an equality with other children of my beloved wife retain upon final distribution by my beloved wife of the residue of the estate herein bequeathed to her. Should my daughter, Mary S. Harbin fail or refuse to take said estate on above condition, then it is my will that some go to my beloved wife as other real estate devised in third section of this my Will.

Fiftieth: I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife, Phas. A. Shelor, Executrix of this my last Will and Testament, with power to employ such assistance as she may require, and she is hereby vested with full and ample power and authority to do all and singular whatsoever is or may be necessary to the execution of this Will without giving Bond and Surety, or accounting to the Ordinary Court.
