declare this my last will and testament in
manner and form following:-

Item 1st

I desire that my body be decently but
imexpensively buried and that by the Masonic
Fraternity if I am deemed worthy.

" 2nd

I desire that all my just debts be paid

" 3rd

I give bequeath and devise to my grand-
daughter M. J. Littlefield the south half of Lot
of land No 124 - 6th Dist, 3rd Section of Gordon
County with all the rights members and appertaining
to the said Lot.

" 4th

I give bequeath and devise to my Grand-
daughter W. Gordon the south half of Lot of land
No 124 - 6th Dist, 3rd Section of Gordon County with all
the rights, members and appertaining to the said Lot.

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" 5th

I give bequeath and devise to my
Grandson John H. Edward and Granddaughters N. M.
and E. L. Edwards one hundred and thirteen acres
of land more or less off of lots of land Nos 86
87 and 88 of 39 except seven acres in 20 Dist
2nd Section also 110 acres more or less off of
No 131 31st Dist 3rd Section all of said land
lying in Bartow County with all the rights
members and appertaining to the said land.

" 6th

I give bequeath and devise to my
Grandchildren the heirs of J. P. Blalock one
hundred acres more or less off of Lots of land
Nos 1377 121 6th Dist 3rd Section of Bartow Co,
also one hundred and forty acres more or less
off of lots of land Nos 1367 121 6th Dist and 3rd Sec
of Gordon County. Said grandchildren not to have
possession of land in Gordon County until
the death of their Grandmother as then and

for her support in another item of this will.

Item 17th

I give bequeath and devise to my daughter Nancy J. Black Lot of land no 133 - 6th Dist 3rd Sec. also lot of land no 134 6th Dist 3rd Sec of Gordon County, Not to take possession of Lot No 134 - 6th Dist and 3rd Sec until after the death of my wife as it is left in another item for her home and support.

" 8th

I give bequeath and devise to my beloved wife R. M. Black a lifetime interest in lot of land no 134 - 6th Dist 3rd Sec Gordon County also a life time interest in 140 acres of land off of Lots Nos 136 and 121 - 6th Dist and 3rd Sec of Gordon County, for her support and maintenance. I also give and bequeath to my beloved wife all monies, notes and or other evidences of claims I may have together with all other perishable property that I may have, possession at my death.

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" 9th

I hereby constitute and appoint J. H. Black and C. R. Black Executors of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all other heretofore made by me.

Witness my hand and seal this the Eleventh day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Ninety Two.
