First my Wish (and) desire is that all my just debts (and) funeral expenses should be paid and the remains of my property of every description & quality should be given to my dear old mother Frances Eason of the State of North Carolina (and) County of Edgecomb for the express purpose of supporting herself (and) her three young Children namely Stephen Eason Harris Eason and Zilpha Eason the entire use & benefit of my said Mother & the said three Children to them and to them only. And I do nominate and appoint my relation Jonathan Ward of the County of Greene my sole and only Executor (and) that he shall act as he may think proper without it be his pleasure -
