In the name of God amen

I Abner Eason formerly of the State of North Carolina (and County of Edge Comb but now of the State of Georgia & County of Greene (and all my relations Jonathan Ward do make) and Ordain this my last Will and Testament.

First my Wish and desire is that all my just debts and funeral Expenses should be paid and the remanance of my property of every description & quality should be given to my dear old mother Frances Eason of the State of North Carolina (and County of Edge Comb for the Express purpose of supporting herself and her three young Children namely Stephen Eason Harris Eason and Zephania Eason the intire use & benefit of my said Mother & the said three Children to them and to them only. And I do nominate and appoint my relation Jonathan Ward of the County of Greene my sole and only Executor, and that he shall act as he may think proper without giving Bond and security as is Commonly done without it be his pleasure -
