Georgia 3 Whereas I Alexander Berry of the County of Greene (and State of Georgia do make (and) ordain this my last Will (and) testament

I now 1st It is my wish that all my just debts (should be paid)

2^d I will (and) bequeath to my Son William Berry all that lot or parcel of Land Containing One hundred (and) twenty eight acres lying on the North side of the tract of Land whereon I now live

3rd I will (and) bequeath to my Son John Berry the tract of Land whereon I now live together with all the appurtenances relative to the same (and) further it is my wish for said John Berry to take particular care (and) attention of his mother and Sister Jane Berry so long as he or they shall live (and) it is further my desire that my son John Berry should have my desk

4th It is my Will (and) desire that after the death of my beloved wife Jane Berry that all the perishable property be Equally divided between all my Children all of which I do hereby acknowledge to be my last Will (and) testament whereunto I have set my hand (and) seal this fourteenth day of October One thousand eight hundred and seventeen
