Georgia In the name of God Amen I Anna Howells of Greene County in the County & State of Georgia calling to mind the uncertainty of life & the certainty of death being of sound & disposing mind I may do make & ordain this my last will & testament

Item I do give my just debts together with my burial funeral expenses paid in the manner hereafter directed

Item I do give unto Ebenezer Baker bond or note for five hundred & fifty dollars also one note in my son Casper Howells for one hundred & fifty dollars with a credit thereon of one hundred & yet due fifty dollars which notes amount to six hundred dollars They will deliver further is that the aforesaid Ebenezer Baker

three hundred dollars of the aforesaid six hundred dollars the two hundred & fifty due on said Baker note I give to my son Casper Howells to be paid by or paid to him on the first day of March eighteen hundred & twenty seven without interest I further give my son Casper the fifty dollars yet due on his note Item the 3rd the debts & expenses attached to in the first item is to be equally divided & paid by my son Casper Howells & my son in law Ebenezer Baker above named Item 4th and will further is that my son in law Ebenezer Baker & my son Casper Howells shall pay to my seven other children

Nathaniel Howells Elizabeth Phillips Baker Nancy Backstay Hartwell Howells & John each the sum of one dollar each that is for Ebenezer Baker to pay the above named seven children three dollars & fifty cents & Casper to pay the other three dollars & fifty cents

Item the 5th I ordain my son Casper Howells my true & lawful executor In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this the fifth day of December eighteen hundred & twenty seven
