Green County, I David Culp being unable to write but perfectly of
sound mind & memory do constitute & declare this to be my last
Will & Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me made
First I give and bequeath to my wife Sarah Culp to it & to her heirs
after her death.

Second I desire that my just debts be paid.
Third I give unto my beloved wife Sarah Culp during her life or
widowhood, One Hundred acres of Land, lying in Jackson County, the
State of Georgia, known as the Phelps land, & One Hundred twenty eight acres
in said State County, known as the Thompson tract. I charge my wife with
paying, then the aforesaid tract of land to go to my three sons, Robert
H. Culp, John W. Culp, Benjamin D. Culp. I give unto my daughter Letitia
Ann Culp, One Hundred and fifty acres. I give my other Real Estate
to my wife, during her life. I desire that my Executors use her own
discretion in raising money to pay my debts, out of my property,
not herein bequeathed, & any balance after paying my just debts, I
desire to be appropriated to the maintenance & education of my Children
and I do hereby make & ordain my wife Sarah Culp, Executor to this my
last Will & Testament. In witness whereof I David Culp, the Testator
have hereunto set my hand & seal, this 7th day of November in the
Year of our Lord, One Thousand Eight Hundred & Forty one.
