

In the Name of God Amen I David Sherrill of the County of Greene and State of Georgia being weak of body but of sound mind and memory, Knowing that it is appointed for me to die do ordain this my last Will and Testament first of all I commend my soul to God who gave it and my body to the Earth to be buried in a decent & Christianlike manner at the discretion of my friends as touching such worldly goods as it hath pleased God to give I bequeath in the following manner viz

I leave (and bequeath) unto my beloved Daughter Sarah Watts a certain negro woman named Rachel a child named Stephen also a tract of Land containing one hundred and sixteen acres One horse Saddle (and) bridle one Cow (and) Calf one Bed & Furniture

I also leave (and bequeath) to my beloved daughter Elizabeth Tooker one hundred and twenty acres of Land whereon she now lives also two negro girls named Cynthia (and) Sarah one horse (and) Saddle one Cow (and) Calf one bed (and) furniture

I also ^{leave} (and bequeath) to my beloved daughter Mary Broach Two negro girls named Melly (and) Emily also one horse (and) Saddle one Cow & Calf one bed (and) furniture

I also ^{leave} (and bequeath) to my beloved Daughter Parshaanna Allford two negro girls named Harriet (and) Parous also one horse (and) Saddle one Cow (and) Calf one bed & Furniture

I also leave (and bequeath) to my beloved son Wilson one negro boy named Tom and one girl named Mary One horse (and) Saddle one Cow (and) Calf one Bed and furniture

I also leave (and bequeath) unto my beloved son David one negro boy named Anthony one girl named Juda one horse Saddle (and) bridle one Cow & Calf one bed and furniture

I also ^{leave} (and bequeath) unto my beloved Daughter Lavinia one negro boy named Abraham one woman named Patience (and) Child named Mary One horse Saddle one Cow (and) Calf one bed & Furniture

I also leave (and bequeath) unto my beloved son Perry one negro boy named Isack one girl named Liza one named Julia one horse Saddle bridle one Cow & Calf one bed & Furniture

I also leave (and bequeath) unto my beloved son William three negroes a boy named Peter & two girls Hyacin (and) Linda one horse & Saddle one Cow & Calf one bed (and) furniture

I also leave (and bequeath) unto my beloved wife Elizabeth five negroes viz Sampson Jack Harry Phoebe Lary and Crease during her natural life with the use of the plantation whereon she now live with the stock plantation utensils house hold & Kitchen furniture at her death all my Land with the premises where I now live is to be equally divided between my three sons David Perry & William also the six negroes Sampson Jack Harry Phoebe Lary & Crease be sold (and) that out of the amount of sale that my daughter Elizabeth Tooker receive one hundred and thirteen Dollars my Daughter Rebecca Moon receive four hundred and twenty three Dollars (and) that my Daughter Mary Broach receive five hundred and twenty three Dollars and that my Daughter Parshaanna Allford receive four hundred and twenty three Dollars also my son Wilson receive Forty Eight Dollars also my son David receive one hundred (and) Eighteen Dollars my daughter Lavinia receive eighteen Dollars also my son Perry receive four hundred (and) Eight twenty three Dollars my son William receive two hundred (and) twenty three Dollars & the balance of the amount of sale of said negroes together with all the stock plantation tools house hold (and) Kitchen furniture to be equally divided between my five children Sarah Watts Rebecca Moon Mary Broach Parshaanna Allford Wilson Sherrill David Sherrill Lavinia Sherrill Perry Sherrill & William Sherrill

I also leave (and bequeath) unto my beloved Daughter Rebecca Moon one negro boy named Jim one horse and Saddle one Cow & Calf one bed & Furniture

I also leave (and bequeath) unto my sons Perry & William a negro girl named

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Charney to be Equally divided between them I do also appoint David Sherrill Will
Nasachi and William Cone my lawful Executors to this my last Will and Testament

I give (and) bequeath to my son John Martin one dollar to him and his heirs forever
I give (and) bequeath to my daughter Hannah Hunt one Dollar to her and her heirs forever
I give (and) bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Sayer one Dollar to her then her heirs forever
I give (and) bequeath to my daughter Anna Richards one Dollar to her then her heirs forever
I give (and) bequeath to my son Abs Martin my hole whole Estate One negro man
two goats one feather bed & furniture of my stock of Cattle all my stock of hogs all my
household and Kitchen furniture of all kinds whatever (and) all the balance of my Estate
whatever to him (and) his heirs forever I do also constitute (and) appoint my son Abs
Martin my hole whole Executor of this my last Will (and) Testament (and) I do hereby
disallow (and) revoke all (and) every other forms Testaments wills or legacies bequeaths ratifying
(and) Confirming this (and) others to be my last will (and) Testament (and) Witness whereof I have
before me set my (hand) (and) seal the day & years above written
