of life and the certainty of death do hereby Ordain this my last Will and Testament
in manner and form as follows viz my will and desire is that all my lawful
debts and funeral Charges (should) be paid

Item 2^d I have already given to my daughter Nancy Palmer one feather Bed and
furniture Item 3^d I give to my son John the best one share gun & four shares

Item 4th I give to my son Veddick James four shares

Item 5th I give to my daughter Lucy one feather Bed and furniture one pot and cover and
one feather Bed and furniture to be divided between Lucy and my daughter Maria. Also
Lucy I give half dozen sitting Chairs

Item 6th I give to my beloved wife Tabitha one loon the balance of my property after
paying all my lawful debts I give to my beloved wife Tabitha

The appoint John Ollinger and my wife Tabitha lawful Executor and Executrix to this
last and will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
affix my seal this 10th October 1820.

State of Georgia I (Duke Cole of said County being in a low estate
Greene County I health but of sound mind and memory and
calling to mind that it is once appointed for all men once to die, do
think proper, and do by these presence make this my last will Testament
The first of all I give my soul to God who gave it, and my body I give
to the Earth in a decent Christian Burial

Item 1st I give to my daughter Sally the whole of my Estate to wit
Real Estate negroes and their increase the whole of my land that I now
have upon, together with my Stock of Horses, Hogs, Cattle and their
increase, my crop of Cotton Corn wheat and Oats together with all my
outstanding debts, my plantation Tools the whole of my Household
and Kitchen furniture and every other article that Composes my Estate and
if particular mentioned

Item 2^d My will is that my friend Robin Cole of said County

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who I shall Appoint one of my Executors) do lay out two thousand Dollars money and debts now in hand) in good land for the benefit of my only child Harriet. My will further is that the said Robin Cole do take my daughter Pally to live with him, and to give her one years schooling to a Common English school and three years to a decent female school. the Expenses to be paid out of my Estate and recommend her to be brought up to industry. Item 5th My will further is that my friend Robin Cole do take Mrs. Sarah Durham to live with him to be decently supported out of Estate as long as she lives.

Item 6th My Will further is that my Executors do sell the tract of land wherein I now live the whole of my Stock of Horses Hogs Cattle my crop of Corn Cotton wheat and Oats upon plantation Tools Household & Kitchen furniture (and) every other Article that Composes my Estate except the negroes one bed & one Walnut Chest and in about two years I wish a good Horse & saddle purchased out of my Estate for my daughter.

Item 6th My will further is that if my daughter should die before she becomes of age or marries then the whole of my Estate to be equally divided between between the heirs of my nephew Robin Cole and my sister Patty Reed.

Witness I Appoint my friends Robin Cole of Jasper County and Graves Swanson of Greene County my Executors to this my last Will (and) Testament signed with my hand & seal this 1st day of November 1820
