On the 11th day of January this tenth day of January 1865
I Edward Bullock of the County of Hancock & of the parish of
St. Martins being very very sick & weak in body but of perfect
sound mind & memory thanks be given unto God therefore calling
unto mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed
for all men once to die do make & declare this as my last will and
testament that is to say principally I first of all I give & recommend
my soul into the hands of Allmighty God that give it & my body
I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial
at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the
general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty
power of God. As touching such worldly estate which with it
hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give devise and
disposed of the same in the following manner I give I give
I give to my daughter Sarah Rice one acre more or less late
John negro man named Charles to her & her heirs forever I likewise
give to my grandson Edward Rice one more more named Sam
(which was born of late the woman which I gave to my daughter
Sarah) He & his heirs forever I likewise give to my son John Bullock
two hundred & fifty acres of land which I have acknowledged to
me by John Young & John Bullock in Deed on the South side

of the Little River & likewise I reserve out of that which I bought
 of John Brown adjoining to the other where be the said John Brown
 likewise two negroes named Mings & Bane & to his heirs forever I likewise
 give to my son Edward Bullock the land which my father Edward Bullock
 gave to me lying in Hanover County with the mill & the appurtenances
 thereto belonging & two negroes named Jack & Miller & their increase
 to him & his heirs forever I likewise give to my son James Bullock
 the rest of the land which I hold in Louisa County & two negroes
 named Tom & Bet & their increase to him & his heirs forever I like-
 wise give to my daughter Mary Bullock two negroes named Hannah
 & Sam & their increase to her & his heirs forever I likewise give to my
 son Micajah the one half of the land which I hold in North Carolina
 being equally divided & two negroes named Joe & Beck & their increase
 forever I likewise give to my daughter Christian Bullock two
 negroes named Dick & Peter & their increase to her & hers forever I
 likewise give to my son William Bullock the other half of the land
 which I hold in North Carolina & my Will my intention is that
 Micajah shall divide the land between he & his brother William &
 then shall give his said brother William choice which part he please
 I likewise two negroes named young Jack & young Ellis & their increase
 to them & their heirs forever I likewise leave the remainder part of
 my estate to be sold & divided equally among my eight children &
 my will meaning is that if my said children should die without issue
 that then their share or part of my estate should be sold & equally divided
 among the living I likewise ordain constitute & appoint Clifton Rice
 my son in law & my two eldest sons John & Edward Bullock to be
 my full & sole executor of this my last will & testament as witness
 my hand & seal the day & year above written

(At a Court held for Hanover County on Thursday the second day of December 1842
 this last will & testament of Edward Bullock deceased was exhibited by Clifton
 Rice John Bullock & Edward Bullock the executors the executors there named
 to be proved who took the oath of executor thereto & the same was also proved by
 the oath of John Cosby Jr & Stephen Perry the witnesses thereto & thereupon admitted
 to record Test John Christwell C. H. C.
