I Elizabeth Perkins of the County of Greene State of Georgia being sick and weak of body but of sound mind and disposing memory Do make Constituted and Ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following to wit I Give unto my Son Thomas for and living in Virginia to have and being the sum of five Dollars being with the sum of all my other due from me to him I Give unto John son of Thomas and Negro the named Dublin to him and his heirs forever I Give unto Francis American Negro daughter of the said Green Negro boy named Daniel and the sum of thirty Dollars to his heirs forever as I Give unto my daughter Sarah Perkins two Negroes the named Betty & Betty & Betty in and during his natural life and as he or she equally divided among I enjoyed by her all the property of her of the said Sarah Perkins including two children the named Malcom Johnston & Leticia Jane Johnston the house the life of James Johnston died her former I Give unto my daughter Nancy Gomez during her natural life a Negro woman named Mary the child Henry but at her decease the Negro including Elizabeth Seneca to return back to her 13 other or their legal representatives including of my son Thomas his heirs I Give to my daughter Leticia Maddox one Negro woman named her (one) her income during her natural life and as she the said Mary and her issue to be equally divided the children of the said Leticia Maddox also the said Dollars I Give said Leticia Maddox to be divided among her children at her decease I Give unto my Grand Son Richard A. Kingston son of Daniel etc. as one Negro boy named Peter to him and his heirs forever as I Give unto my daughter Elizabeth son of one Negro woman named and his child Stephen & also one half of all the property that after paying Greene County Wills and the sum of my daughter's share of her share during her natural life I Give to my daughter Mary the child Henry but at her decease the
