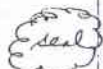
A Record of the last Will & Testament
 of Benjamin Gilbert, deceased

In the name of God, Amen, I Benjamin
 Gilbert, being through the abundance of
 God goodness and mercy, tho' weak in
 body, yet of a sound and perfect under-
 standing, & memory, do constitute
 this my last Will & Testament & desire
 to be received by all as such. I
 most humbly bequeath unto God, my
 soul, beseeching his most gracious
 acceptance of it. I give my body
 to earth from whence it was taken
 in full assurance of its resurrection
 from thence at the last day. As for
 my burial, I desire it should be sent
 without pomp or state, at the discretion
 of my executors after named. I give
 unto my dear & loving wife all the
 property that she had when I married

cow by the name of Shelly, one
cow and calf, one sow, one feather bed,
to her & her heirs forever. I give
unto my loving son Benjamin Gilbert,
one negro girl known by the name
of Henry, unto him & his heirs forever.
I give unto my loving son Martin
Gilbert, one negro boy known by the
name of Reuben, 1 cow and calf to him
his heirs forever. I give unto Michael
Gilbert my son, and Benjamin Gilbert
my son, being two of my executors,
one negro bench known by the name
of Ambaky; only the next first child
shall be my youngest daughter Shelly,
unto them & their heirs forever. I give
unto Clement Miller one negro boy
known by the name of Aaron, one
feather bed unto her & her heirs
forever. I give unto my loving
daughter Betsey one negro man,
known by the name of Tom, to her
& her heirs forever. I give unto
