Georgia. I Harvey Edwards of the State of Georgia do hereby certify and
 Green County being a sound & disposing mind & memory but
 laboring under the pressure of disease I feel the necessity of
 making temporary here have therefore thought proper to
 make this my last will & testament hereby revoking all others
 by me previously made. I give & bequeath unto Anne
 & Edward my silver & pew watch chain & seal
 Secondly It is my will & desire that all the balance of my estate of
 whatever nature or kind it may consist after the payment
 of my just debts shall be equally divided among my relatives
 according to the laws of Georgia
 Thirdly It is further my will & desire that all the goods wares &
 merchandise now in the possession of Harvey Edwards & or which
 may hereafter arrive or be received or be received on their
 account at their establishment in Greensborough shall be disposed
 by my executor hereafter appointed for the use & benefit of my
 partners & each of my heirs as may be entitled to a general
 Legacy or special Legacy under my will & I further desire that
 the clerks now employed by H Edwards & Co shall be continued
 by my executor in the employment of the concern until the
 business of the same be settled up or their term of service expires
 Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute & appoint Anna Hangerford
 my sole executor to this my last will & testament In testimony whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 29th
