

In the name of God Amen I Henry Lanier of the County of Greene being of sound and disposing mind memory do make ordinance and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following that I give and bequeath to my son Orasmus one negro man named Mandel also one negro woman named Peter and one feather bed furniture of the best I have to him and his heirs forever.

I give and bequeath to my son Jefferson one negro man named Sam Also one negro girl named Maria and one feather bed and furniture of the best I have to him and his heirs forever.

I give and bequeath to my son Rubin one negro boy named Merica One negro boy named Riley also one negro girl named Emily one feather bed of the best I have to him and his heirs forever.

All my other property consisting my land stock of horses cattle sheep hogs and crops household and kitchen furniture I direct to be disposed of the following manner to wit: In the event of the death of any one of the before mentioned slaves before my son Jefferson attains to lawful age, then I direct any land stock of all kinds as before enumerated, crops household & kitchen furniture and plantation utensils are to be sold to the best advantage by my executors herein after named, and the money arising therefrom, together with all money which may be due or coming due to be disposed of as shall hereafter be directed. I further direct that all my slaves shall be held out privately and to themselves masters until such time as any one of my sons shall attain to lawful age or marry and then my desire is that my executors herein after named shall value all the slaves giving to such as shall have attained to lawful age or married the part heretofore directed them making up such part as may be deficient in value out of the money arising from the sales heretofore directed until all shall have one equal third part and the balance equally divided among the three first having attained my youngest son Rubin Equal with my other two and purchased or reserved money for that purpose.

My further will and desire is that son Orasmus shall be continued in his present business; that my son Jefferson be put into the same business and that my son Rubin after having received the schooling heretofore directed shall likewise be placed under the care of some steady merchantile gentleman for instruction in the same branch of business: I further direct my executors herein after named shall have the whole and sole management of my Estate, Act as Guardians for my children and dispose of the whole in such manner, as to them shall seem most advantageous for my children until such time as heretofore herein pointed out for a delivery of the property, without recourse to any judicial authority whatsoever. And lastly I nominate and appoint my friends Lazarus Battle Orasmus Lanier Rubin Major and Thomas Crawford to be my executors to this my last will and testament revoking all others heretofore made.

and State of Georgia being in great weakness of body but of a sound mind
memory (and calling to mind) that it is appointed for man to die I have the
proper to make this my last will (and) testament after recommending my soul
to God that gave it (and) through the intercession of a dear Redeemer having a less
hope of a happy immortality I do hereby dispose of my worldly goods in the
following to wit

1st My wife is that all my lawfull debts be paid

2nd I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Lucy 5 Years One hundred ac-
res (and) going the tract I now live on deeded to me by George Johnson & two
les includes the place where Mr. Garret formerly lived on the whole including
one hundred acres together with the appurtenances belonging thereto. I give my
greatest to my beloved wife Lucy I leave to her immediately after my de-
ath one negro boy named Lewis also one Negy mare saddle and Bridle
one choice Cow and Calf also her choice sow and pig also her choice sow a
pig also her choice bed & bedding & two sets of clothing for said bed one pi-
table a small Walnut do one Cupboard half dozen Chaires Cups & saucers &c
half dozen plates and Knives & forks three setting Chairs two bunches one wheel &
& frame (and) all the glass & flannel (and) all that belong thereto with a pot over-
neath & kettle & two dishes (and) six hundred weight of pork the first year
of my wife's life (and) the use of the plantation and improvement all on the south side
of the road for four years after my death also five hundred weight of meat
(and) five barrels of Corn of do to be reserved from this mill for the use of
my beloved wife for six years after my death also two tables Cloths and curtains for
and little table glass it is to be observed that the (be) clothing above named is
to include the bedclothing my wife brought here with her pillow & else-
where for next year

3rd Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Anna 5 Years one bed and fu-
riture and the place carpet as her part of my estate with one
Greene County Will part of my estate

4th Item I give and bequeath to my son Augustus 15 Years one negro woman

also two hundred Dollars of my estate
