

Peccaniah Moore Will

I Peccaniah in the name of God Amen do make known this to be my last will & testament do devise bequeath & dispose of it in manner & form following to wit

Item I give devise bequeath to my loving wife Nancy her negroes by name Francis Sarah Pinks Wash Kate Dicks Vinny Mary Ann & Rachel together with all my lands stock household & kitchen furniture all the carriage & farming tools together with my crop &c. & the residue of any estate of whatsoever kind it may be to her & the heirs of her body forever

Item 2nd I give bequeath devise unto my daughter Nancy one negro man named David in addition to what I have already given her to her then heirs forever

Item 3rd I give bequeath to my daughter Elipah five dollars in addition to one negro by name Ed which was heretofore given her to her then heirs forever

Item 4th I give bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth five dollars in addition to one negro boy named Pim heretofore given to her & her heirs forever

Item 5th I give bequeath unto my daughter Cynthia five dollars in addition to one negro man named Bob which was heretofore given to her & her heirs forever

Item 6th I give devise bequeath unto my daughter Peggy five dollars in addition to one negro boy named Moss which I have heretofore given her to her & her heirs forever

Item 7th I give devise bequeath unto my daughter Martha five dollars in addition to four hundred fifty dollars heretofore given her to her & her heirs forever

Item 8th I give bequeath to my daughter Rebecca five hundred dollars to be bequeathed out of my estate to her & her heirs forever

Item 9th It is further my will & desire that all my just debts & the above named legacies be paid out of my estate which I have given my beloved wife Nancy

Item 10th Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute & appoint my loving wife Nancy William H. Shinn & executors to this my last will & testament & seeing all other household goods &c.
