

Jesse Doole's Will

George In the name of God Amen, I Jesse Doole of the above County & State being reduced
 (Green) through & low by illness and wearing help as uncertain but thing of sound mind (and memory) do make
 and constitute this my last will & Testament (my)

Item 1st I will that all my lands together with my stock and all other of my property not herein after
 disposed of to go and from the proceeds thereof all my just debts be paid

Item 2nd I will to my beloved wife, ^{and} my negro man by the name of Jim & one negro woman Lavinia together
 with her increase two beds bedside furniture, one set of Walnut Tables & one pine Cupboard
 during her lifetime or widowhood & upon her death or marriage to be equally divided between my
 children Emily J. Doole, Nancy & Fuller, Deborah M. Doole & one fourth part to Delilah &
 Barnwell to be managed as herein after directed.

Item 3rd I will to my daughter Emily J. Doole one bed Bedstead & furniture & Fifty Dollars

Item 4th I will to my son Deborah M. Doole one bed Bedstead & furniture & Fifty Dollars and the
 expense of one year schooling at a good Country school.

Item 5th I will to my daughter Delilah M. Barnwell one fourth part of my Estate not heretofore
 disposed of to be held in trust by my Executors for the aforesaid Delilah & that she have all the
 interest & profits arising from the same during her natural lifetime and at her death if she has
 no heirs of her body to belong to the rest of my children or their legal representatives, but provided
 she shall have a surviving child or children it shall be equally divided between them.

Item 6th I will that the other three fourths of my Estate be equally divided between my children
 Emily J. Doole, Nancy & Fuller & Deborah M. Doole

Item 7th I will that my Executors have power to make such division. By a division of my negroes or
 by a sale of the same which in their wisdom they may conceive most advantageous to the legatee.

Item 8th I constitute and appoint Thomas & James & Wm. Doole my lawful Executors to this
 my last will & Testament to execute the same according to the tenor thereof
