2nd It is my will that all my Estate remains in the hands of my wife for the purpose of supporting and Educating my Children

3rd When my Children shall come of lawful age or marry to draw there part of my Estate calculating at the seventh part real and personal to be done by three men Chosen by my Executors for that purpose

4th It is my will the part of my Estate remaining in the hands of my wife after her death be equally divided between all my Children

5th I give my son Hilsman Baley one Horse worth Eight Dollars which is to be Calculated in with his part of the E Estate

6th I Appoint Robert Haynes and my son Hilsman Baley my Executors
