

Subal Watts Will

Greene County. I know all men by these presents, That I Subal Watts knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die and being very sick and feeble in body but of sound and disposing memory do make this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and annulling all others wills whatever - So confirm this and this only to be my last Will and Testament. -

First I Recommend my soul to God who gave it and my Body to the grave to be entred in a decent Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors herein after mentioned and as touching my worldly goods I give and dispose of the same in the following manner and form. -

First My desire is that the property that came by my wife Nancy be given to her a gain Namely Begg Girl named Jalia one Gray Horse Saddle - Bridle one Cow and calf, one Bed Furniture, one Trunk and four chairs - also it is my desire that she should have another Bed and furniture, and all the ballances of my household and kitchen furniture and that she have nothing further of my Estate whatever. -

Secondly the ballance of my Estate of every description whatever to be sold on such terms and terms as my Executors may deem most to the Interest of my estate and that my Slave Ben be valued by three disinterested persons and that the choosing of his own master provided the person whom he chooses will give the price set on him, and after the whole of my estate is turned into money it is my Will that all my just debts be paid, the ballance to be divided between my Daughter Sarah and the child that my wife Nancy is now pregnant with and should either the child or my wife be born alive it is my Will that the survivor shall have the whole of my Estate, so left, and should it so happen, that either my Daughter Sarah or the child that my wife is pregnant with be raised till they are of age a money - That it is my Will and desire, that the property given them be equally divided between my Brother Richard W. Watts and my sisters Mary Watts and Martha Watts - Lastly - I do hereby nominate and appoint David S. Watts and Cordial N. Daniel my sole Executors to this my last Will and Testament.

Greene County In the name of God Amen - I Robert
Wright of the State and County aforesaid being weak in body
but of sound mind have made and ordained this my
last Will and Testament. -

1st I give my body to the dust to be interred at the discretion of my
Executors my soul I recommend to God who gives it. -

2nd My Will is that all my Just be paid by my Executors
as soon after my decease as practicable. -

3rd I give and bequeath to my two sons Robert Wright and Joseph
Wright, the tract of lands that I purchased of Williams Brown
and not heretofore disposed of by me, to be equally divided
according to quality and quantity.

4th I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Wright the two tracts of land
which I purchased of James & Daniel and William Allen. -

5th I give and bequeath to my son Michael Wright Abraham, Cynthia,
James, Skilton, Phibe, Adeline, & Jackson as his full portion of
my Estate. -

6th I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sally Cook, Toby, Lilla, -
Cynthia, Little Jenny, Amy, Achild, Melvay, Charlotte, Pleasant,
& Girl Spencer, Caroline, and Mary as her full portion of
my Estate.

7 I give and bequeath to my Daughter Betsy whattly Jenny, George,
Smith, Young, Sarah, Hannah, Maria, Iudham, Melvay as her full
portion of my Estate.

8th I Give and bequeath my Executors hereafter named Robert Wright
Thomas Wright Joseph Wright and Thomas Cooks in trust for my
